

MARTIN JAN STRÁNSKÝ

Doctor, publisher of magazines *Přítomnost* and *The New Presence*, publicist, consultant. Born in the USA, lives in the Czech Republic. Lecturer in Neurology, Charles University School of Medicine and St. George's University, Assistant Clinical Professor of Neurology, Yale School of Medicine. Founder of the Prague Selective, the largest European summer medical study program for medical students in the world. Member of Advisory committee, Senate commission on Czechs living abroad, Senate of the Czech Republic.

Dr. Stránský's great-grandfather founded *Lidové noviny*, the country's oldest paper, and was a Minister in the first Czechoslovak government. His grandfather was deputy premier of the Czechoslovak Government in Exile, Minister of Justice and Minister of Education, while continuing in the family's publishing activities (17 periodicals in all). His father Jan was an MP and went on to co-found the Czechoslovak desk of Radio Free Europe.
