David Vaughan is a broadcaster and journalist living in Prague.

For eight years he was Editor-in-Chief of Radio Prague, the international service of Czech Radio, and prior to that he was a correspondent for the BBC. He is the author of numerous radio documentaries for both the BBC and Czech Radio, and in 2001 he received the main annual Czech radio award, the Prix Bohemia, for his documentary "Tale of Two Villages".

He has also worked for television, as author and co-director of the documentary "The Second Life of Lidice" (Czech Television 2002). For several years he sat on the steering committee of the International Broadcasting Group in the European Broadcasting Union, during which time he initiated a number of pioneering projects involving cooperation between international public service broadcasters.
